We need people to help with:

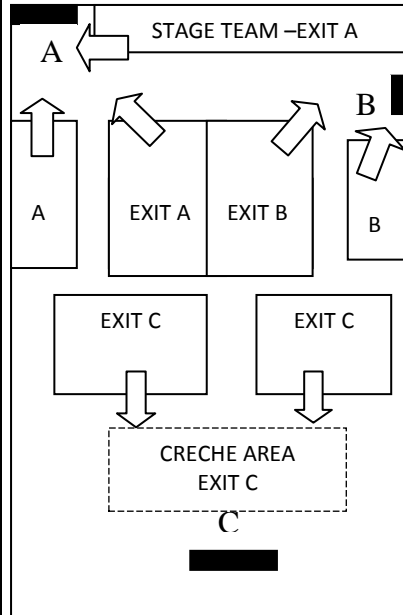
Setting up

FIRE SAFETY

In the event of fire or other emergency please vacate the building by the nearest exit. There are three fire exits – the main front door, the door to the left of the stage and the door to the right side of the main hall. Use this guide so you are not all trying to squash through the same door!



Walk calmly and do not panic; follow instructions. If you have children in the crèche please DO NOT try to go upstairs; the crèche team will take the children to the assembly point.

The assembly point for Exits A and B is the back car park, and the assembly point for Exit C is the front car park. Stand well away from the building.

Do not try to take your car out of the car park until you are told it is safe to do so. You may block the exit, cause accidents and obstruct a fire engine trying to get in. We will be able to open the back gate into Alliance Terrace if needed so please be patient and stay safe.
